

2015-2017 Recommendations 1,475 recommendations issued. Implementation rate stood at 43% In 2018, implementation rate for 2015-2017 recommendations reached 60% following SAI's proactive involvement

IT Audit - Addressing Challenges in Digitalisation

Established in 2016 following increased digitalization in public services and demand for higher information security

- 5 dedicated audits completed since inception and 3 in progress
 - > 21 integrated IT audits completed
 - 6 internal IT audits/assessments performed




